ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The achievements of the Society during the considered period were in form of successful implementation and handling of the programs as below.

1. WOMEN SEWING & WEAVING TRAINING PROGRAM

The Society has organized various programs for sewing training at District. Most of women participants attended this program. The NGO's and the member of Society trained the women and also asked to help women in rural & urban areas that they become independent and to be able to face the financial problem which always happens in their life time to time.

2. PROGRAM FOR AWARENESS TO SAVE ENVIORNMENT

The Society organized a camp at district on World Environment Day to discuss the impact of growing pollution on the human health and environment. The eminent speakers discussed the factors tending to increase in all types of pollution including water, air and sound pollution. It was felt that there is need to speed up the process of removing old vehicle, reduce the use of plastics, Compulsory use of effluent treatment plants by the industries and all other methods which can be helpful in reducing and controlling the pollution.

On the same day the society organized program comprising of a painting contest and a debate on the issues concerning pollution. A number of students were participating from different schools. At the end of the program prizes were distributed among the winners of this contest.

3. **WOMEN & CHILD HEALTH CAMP**

Women & Child Healthcare Program was organized to making women aware from about their health needs and nutrition was organized by the Society. This program was organized by the rural women in large number and it was felt by the attendant that this kind of programs are very useful in our villages where women were aware about their various informed about their health needs a very low. Further they were informed about various kinds of schemes formed and executed by the different government department for welfare of the women either it is in education, employment or technical guidance etc.

The women participating in the program were informed about need for education in the safe reliance of the women. They realized the need for education and agreed to send their children particularly the girl child to school. Further it was resolved that the society will further organize similar program in the near future.

4. **CONSUMER WELFARE PROGRAM**

Consumer Awareness Camps were organized to make public aware of the rights available under the Consumer Protection Act, 1986. The program was highly appreciated by the attendants. It is generally found that the consumers, despite of paying competitive prices are offered low quality products by the companies. Though the products are packed in very attractive packages but their quality happens to be very low. These way consumers get cheated every day by the producers and sellers. The situation is not too different in the cases of service also. The attendants of the program were explained various remedies available to them under the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 and the rules and procedures for filing the suit way and manner of filing the appeals.

5. **PROGRAM ON WOMEN RIGHT**

The Society has organized a program on women right at District. Most of women participants attended this program. The NGO's and the member of Society told about the fundamental rights of the women and also asked to educate all the women in rural & urban areas that they became able to face the problem which always happens in their life time to time.

6. **AIDS & CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAM**

No disease has ever ended the life, the way AIDS does. HIV has become the biggest challenge before the mankind as because it is an infectious disease the danger that it poses is immense. The only way to escape AIDS is to be aware of all the ways in which AIDS can take place. A camp was organized by the Society at Block of District to educate people about the causes of AIDS and the precautions that one should take at the time of taking injections, blood etc., besides this the experts also described in details the reasons for cancer and the precautions needed to be taken generally to

remain safe from cancer. The awareness campaign against AIDS included road shows and small meetings in the villages.

- 7. VOCATIONAL, COMPUTER & HANDICRAFT TRAINING PROGRAM**
Keeping in the mind the objectives of removal of poverty by reducing the problems of employment the society has started a Vocational Training Program. In this training Woman & Youths are provided training in different field like knitting & tailoring, Chikan Embroidery, Type and Shorthand, Food Processing, Fashion Designing Etc. by experienced trainers. In this center trainees are provided training in field of manual Art known as handicraft. The main aim of this program is to make the trainees so skilled that they may become self dependent and stand on their own feet.
- 8. WATER CONSERVATION, SANITATION & HYGIENE AWARENESS PROGRAM**
Drinking Water, Sanitation & Hygiene Awareness Program was organized by the Society. The Main aim of the society is to provide pure & clear water so the wells, Tube wells & ponds were cleared by the help of the Members of the Society. The Members of the Society aware the public about the water which they use and society also has been very active in the field of raising awareness about good sanitation facilities in the slum areas. Lack of good sanitation facilities is curse for the majority of the urban population disproportionately increasing. Population has made the situation more worsened. All the efforts made by the civic authorize have failed to achieve the targets. There is need for voluntary organization to come forward and help the civic authorities in providing sanitation facilities to more and more people. Our society has created various sanitation infrastructures during previous financial year and further it organized various cleanliness drives in various localities.
- 9. ROAD SFETY PROGRAM**
Program on road safety was organized by the member of society. The main objective of the program was to make aware the public by the rules of the roads and benefit of these rules. The program was appreciated by the public very much.
- 10. AWARENESS PROGRAM FOR DRUG ADDICTION**

13. WELFARE & EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME FOR STREET CHILDREN

The eminent speakers discussed the factors leading to increase in all types of pollutions including water, air and sound pollution. It was felt that there is need to speeden the process of removing old vehicles. Reduce the use of plastics, compulsory use of effluent treatment plants by the industries and all the other methods, which can be helpful in reducing and controlling the pollution. On the same day the society organized a programme comprising of a painting contest and a debate on the issues concerning pollution. A number of students were participating participants of different schools. At the end of the programme prizes were distributed among the winners of the contest. This special action indicated a lasting tradition of promoting tree plantation in the projects in cooperation with local communities, government forest offices, and government and state run educational institutes.

6. CONSUMER WELFARE PROGRAMME

Consumer awareness camps were organized to make public aware of the rights available under the consumer protection Act, 1986. The programmes were highly appreciated by the attendants. It is generally found that the consumers, despite of paying competitive prices are offered low quality by the companies. Though the products are packed in very attractive packages but. Their quality happens to be very low. This way consumer get cheated every day by the producers and sellers. The situation is not too different in the cases of services also. The attendants of the programme were explained various remedies

available to them under the consumer protection act, 1986 and the Rules and producers for filling the suit way and manner of filling the appeals. Further they were given names and addresses of different consumer associates whom they can contact in case of need.

7. VOCATIONAL & HANDICRAFT TRAINING PROGRAMME

Keeping in the mind the objectives of removal of poverty by reducing the problem of employment, the society has been instrumental in taking various concrete steps in the direction of removal of poverty. Society has started a vocational training programme. In this training programme woman and youth are provided training in different field like knitting & tailoring. Chicken embroidery, Readymade Garment, Food Processing, Fashion Designing etc. by experienced trainers. In this center trainers are provided training in field of manual art known as handicraft. The main aim of this programme is to make the trainees so skilled that they may become self-dependent and stand on their own feet.

8. SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING PROGRAMME

Chicken embroidery, Readymade Garment, Food Processing, Fashion Designing etc. by experienced trainers. In this center trainers are provided training in field of manual art known as handicraft. The main aim of this programme is to make the trainees so skilled that they may become self-dependent and stand on their own feet. Skill Development Cell has been entrusted the responsibility to train youth by providing them skills through AICTE approved Colleges/Registered facilitators with objective for enhancing their Employment/Self-Employment opportunities. The cell is running various schemes to meet its objectives.

9. YOGA AWARENESS PROGRAMME

Yoga aims at bringing the different bodily functions into perfect coordination so that they work for the good of the whole body. Naturopathy is not just a system of medicine but a way of life based mainly on the ancient practice of the application of the simple laws of nature. Naturopathy stimulates positive thinking, lowers stress, anxiety & depression, improves overall health, enhances outlook, boosts optimism, and improves one's ability to cope with health-related issues.

10. MINORITY WELFARE PROGRAMME

Despite of passing of so many years after the independence-scheduled caste scheduled tribes and minorities have yet been associated in the main stream of the society. They still need a lot of support a not only from the Government but it also from the society and NGO'S. Understand its responsibility the society has organized a number of progresses targeted at the welfare of the SC/ST/OBC, S. This includes imparting non-tonal education in the areas of SC/ST/OBC's, providing them technical and financial help in setting up their own business and pursuing higher studies.

11. ROAD SAFETY PROGRAMME

The member of society organized a programme on road safety. The main aim of this programme was too aware the public by the rules of the roads and the benefit of these rules. The public appreciated the programme very much.

12. HUMAN RIGHTS AWARENESS PROGRAMME

Human rights are standards that recognize and protect the dignity of all human beings. Human rights govern how individual human beings live in society and with each other, as well as their relationship with the State and the obligations that the State have towards them.

13. RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Free medical camps are set up with a sacred aim to bring awareness amongst the deprived population of the country who have no access to basic healthcare services or knowledge about the diseases they are suffering from.
